In October 2004 the EASA Media Anthropology Network set up a mailing list to ease the exchange of information and cooperation among network participants. The list has grown steadily ever since - mostly by word of mouse - and we now have more than 1,500 subscribers from a wide range of backgrounds and locations.

We use the list to share information on media anthropology events, publications, jobs, etc, as well for spontaneous discussions which complement the more structured e-seminars. PDF documents of these discussions will be made freely available on this page from time to time.
